Budget for 2006/2007

THIS is down from last year's by nearly £16,500. Since October 2005, in turn, each of the Council's six committees have been deliberating over their budgets, giving consideration to various projects and requests for assistance from local organisations. Below are the details of their final decisions.

General Administration: £80,300. Community Centre and Curzon Cinema - part lottery match funding £6,250 each.

Allotments Committee: £4,400, includes boundary maintenance and site fence works.

Amenity Committee: £13,500, includes Herbert Garden upkeep, Christmas lights contract and dog bin emptying.

Environment & Planning Committee:

£1,900 includes tree watering and environment enhancement.

Liaison Committee: £ 37,875 includes this newsletter, grants to Clevedon organisations, Victim Support grant, Citizens Advice Bureau Clevedon provision, Brunel Bi-centenary event.

Property Committee: £40,000 for Triangle Clock winding/maintenance, Village Hall and Council House costs, skate park and youth and community centre, contingency.

Transport & Highways Committee: £17,500, for Nailsea and District Community Transport, new bus shelters and repairs.

TOTAL BUDGET £207,975.

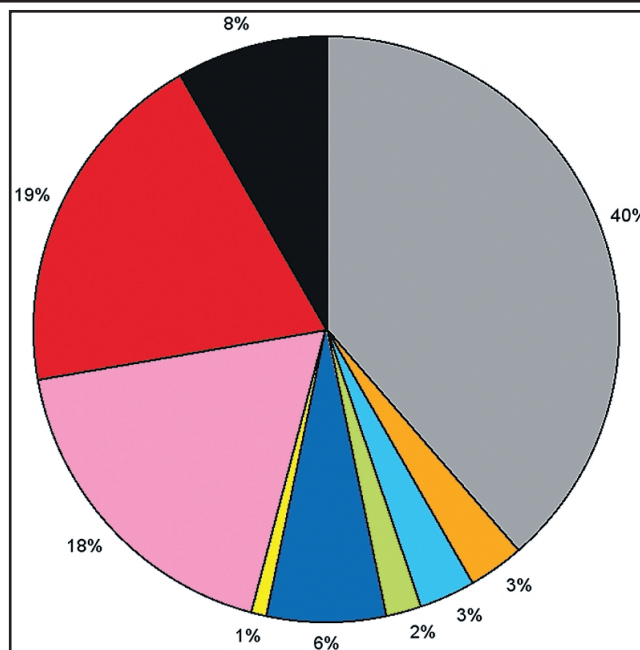
