Getting there ...

GETTING there ... and home again is often a problem for the elderly and disabled and others without personal transport.

We summarise here a number of very different, helpful services available to Clevedon citizens

- The 800 round-the-town bus. Leaflets describing the routes taken daily by the continuously circulating bus are available, they also give times, stops and service details. The bus can be hailed from the pavement as well as making scheduled stops.

- Nailsea and District Community Transport runs eight vehicles all specially adapted for use by disabled citizens as well as the able-bodied. One of the vehicles is dedicated for use in Clevedon.

Details of what can be offered and the fares involved can be obtained by ringing 01275 855552. You will find availability for shopping on named days and for other purposes. Monday and Thursday mornings and afternoons. £1.90 charge - shopping only.

- Not forgetting the charity Clevedon Care, fresh from its 20th anniversary in 2007. Pick up pamphlets at the library and surgeries or its office in St Johns Lower Hall in Hillside Road. By ringing 01275 343677 between the hours of 9.30am-12noon and 2.15-4.30pm, a driver can be arranged to take you door-to-door on any kind of medical appointment in the town, at various clinics and at the hospitals in Bristol and Weston. A donation is requested according to the distance travelled.

Clevedon grants
