TEA/18/758 REPORTS FROM TOWN COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVES ON OUTSIDE BODIES;

Community Association Cllr Barton reported they have bookings for the next 18 months, community groups are using the rooms and some repairs have been done.

N Somerset Safety & Coastal Advisory Group – At the recent meeting, the following was discussed:- Jet Ski's – WSM have CCTV and Rangers to monitor jet ski activity. They have a warning system of 3 'strikes' for any bad behaviour. If this occurs, then launch permit revoked. NSC were asked that if we provided evidence of bad behaviour, could this count towards one of the 3 'strikes', they confirmed they would.

Clevedon Sailing Club has produced a report using county archives trying to establish ownership of the slipway. Report implies UDC 'controlled and maintained' slipway for number of years and substantiates claim that slipway is owned by NSC. Report has been sent to NSC to comment review.

Clevedon Civic Society - Minutes of the meeting held on 5th April 2018 were available at the meeting.

Strode Leisure Centre User Group – No meeting. It was requested that regular meetings be set up with the Leisure Centre so that we can keep in touch with any issues.

Clevedon Pier Trust - No meeting.

Clevedon Sailing Club Ctte Cllr B Hatch reported the same comments concerning the slipway as per the N Somerset Safety & Coastal Advisory Group report.

Clevedon Twinning Association Cllr G Watkins reported the twinning of the four towns has enabled Clevedon School to become part of the Erasmus project. Twinning has made a donation towards travel costs for the children coming to Clevedon in June 2018.

CANS Cllr B Hatch reported that plenty of fundraising is taking place.

Police & Communities Together - Meeting on 13 March 2018, with next meeting planned for 1 May 2018. Cllr Hill reported there has been no spike of activity in the Clevedon area and Clevedon now has a new sergeant. Minutes from Neighbourhood Watch meeting held on 26 March 2018 were available at the meeting.

Gwilliam & Woodward Trust - Meeting on 9 April 2018. Cllr A Shopland reported that funding had been given to support a school trip and new books.

MARLENS Trustees Cllr B Cherokoff reported the team are very busy spreading the good word of Clevedon, the water sports on offer and tourism. They have linked up with the British long distance swimming association.
