NSC Streets & Open Spaces Update items;

- **Badger Bridge on Poets Walk – Grant related works**
Update – NSC are awaiting news from Natural England
- **Elton Road – overgrown vegetation onto public highway**
Update – NSC Streets & Open Spaces officer continuing to monitor hedge and will arrange for cutback if vegetation becomes an obstruction.
- **Hill Road – broken paving on public highway**
Action: Cllr Geldart agreed to contact the Traders and explain what their responsibility is for maintaining the pavement areas outside their businesses
- **Jacobs Walk, Strode Road – poor condition of path surface** – Path is the ownership of NSC. Land Yeo Friends are seeking funding to repair the path.
- **Wheelchair access – Poets Walk/St Andrews Church Entrance** – Members concerned that wheelchair access was not level and step still existed between the footpath and the slope. Committee Clerk reported concern to NSC Officer.

NEW ITEMS -

- **Victorian Shelter – Clevedon Seafront**
The shelter paintwork needs refreshing and replacement of the windows with a non-breakable material
- **Bandstand – Clevedon Seafront**
The paintwork on the Bandstand ceiling requires attention
Update – NSC Officer advised that cosmetic works only are required. Prices to be obtained.

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
